Constitutionalism and Publicness in the new Global order: A Shifting Relationship

Neil Walker holds the Regius Chair of Public Law and the Law of Nature and Nations at the University of Edinburgh.

His main area of expertise is constitutional theory. He has published extensively on the constitutional dimension of legal order at sub-state, state, supranational and international levels. He has also published at length on the relationship between security, legal order and political community. He maintains a more general interest in broader questions of legal theory as well as in various substantive dimensions of UK and EU public law. Some of his recent publications are a book on 'Europe's Constitutional Mosaic' co-edited with Jo Shaw and Stephen Tierney (Hart, 2011) and 'The Anti-Political Polity' published in the *Modern Law Review* (2010).
