The Chair "International Macroeconomics and Financial Markets" at the Faculty of Business, Economics and Social Sciences, Department of Socioeconomis, at the University of Hamburg invites applications for the following position, to be filled as of 01.09.2023,

Student Research Assistant (studentische oder wissenschaftliche Hilfskraft)

for 4-8 hours per week for at least six months (with the option to prolong the contract). Work is not bound to a certain location but can be done flexibly from everywhere.

The chair "International Macroeconomics and Financial Markets" by Prof. Dr. Johanna Krenz engages in research and teaching in macroeconomics, with a focus on the role of financial markets in the (international) transmission of shocks and the optimal design of different central bank policies. In large parts, research is of theoretical nature, developing and employing so-called *Dynamic Stochastic General Equilibrium (DSGE)* models. Furthermore, modern econometric methods are employed, such as Local Projections.

Tasks1:

- Assistance in the new research project "Macroprudential Policy and Systemic Risk in Europe", e.g.
 - Searching scientific literature
 - Reviewing financial stability reports
 - Supporting the documentation of research outcome
- Support in preparing the lecture "Macroeconomics"
- Updating the chair's homepage

Requirements:

Student of Socioeconomis or Economics (Bachelor/Master)

- Good knowledge of the subject of macroeconomics, ideally also of international macroeconomics and/or monetary economics
- Good computer skills, especially Latex, Stata, Matlab
- Good language skills in English and German (research is exclusively in English, teaching exclusively in German)
