The position in accordance with Section 28 subsection 3 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) commences as soon as possible.

This is a fixed-term contract in accordance with Section 2 of the academic fixed-term labor contract act (Wissenschaftszeitvertragsgesetz, WissZeitVG). The term is fixed until 31st of March 2021. The position calls for 50 % of standard work hours per week**.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Duties primarily include teaching and research. Research associates may also pursue independent research and further academic qualifications.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

The position is foreseen to last for one year as a stand-in for the holder of the post. The duties include teaching in macroeconomics, European Economics and International Economics as well as other scientific tasks at the chair. The teaching load is 2.5 teaching hours (LVS).

REQUIREMENTS:

A university degree in a relevant field. Very good German and English language skills are expected, knowledge of econometrics is desirable.
