BECOME A RESEARCHER AT THE CSS

The CSS offers institutional attachment to third-party funded projects with thematic relevance to the research foci of the CSS. As an institutional actor, the CSS provides an organizational framework for interdisciplinary exchange and networking both within and outside the center and the university, as well as a platform for communicating members' research results to the public. In addition, there is the possibility to financially support new, interdisciplinary research ideas with start-up funds and to promote the activities of young scientists with grants.

For a successful and productive integration into the CSS each research project has to be assigned to at least one CSS member that acts as a host to the project.

The CSS board of directors decides about the admission. The number of projects that can be hosted by the CSS depends on the spatial and financial possibilities.

What we offer:

- The university will take over employer responsibilities during your funding period and provide the conditions necessary for you to carry out your project (e.g. provide a workplace at the CSS)
- Integration into the CSS as a research environment and the CSS network
- Introduction by the board of directors
- Participation in CSS event formats and as CSS members also in Working Groups
- (International) Visibility of the project through the CSS

How to apply:

Find at least one CSS member that acts as a host to your project first. A list of our members with links to their personal websites you can find <u>here</u>.

Then, please send a short description (up to two pages) of your project or project proposal and a short CV to css.wiso@uni-hamburg.de. The project description should address the following points:

- Relation to the CSS research topics
- Planned involvement in CSS activities (e.g. events, working paper series, working groups)
- Nomination of CSS members (professors) that would act as a host
