CLUSTER OF EXCELLENCE 'CLIMATE, CLIMATIC CHANGE AND SOCIETY' (CLICCS, CEN) CLICCS B2 WORK PACKAGE 2

The next few years of climate governance-in-the-making are critical: observing them closely allows us to identify and assess key drivers of long-term social trends towards or away from decarbonization, which form – individually and through their interaction at different governance scales – the backdrop of possible and plausible scenarios of future climate governance. As such, the Cluster of Excellence Climate, Climatic Change and Society (CLICCS) focuses on the overarching question: 'Which climate futures are possible and which are plausible?'. The research group CLICCS B2 (composed of three Work Packages) investigates the 'Dynamics of Climate Governance: Norms, Contestation, and Policies', while Work Package 2 looks more specifically at contestations of climate governance norms and the diverse meanings and contested use of 'climate justice'.
