

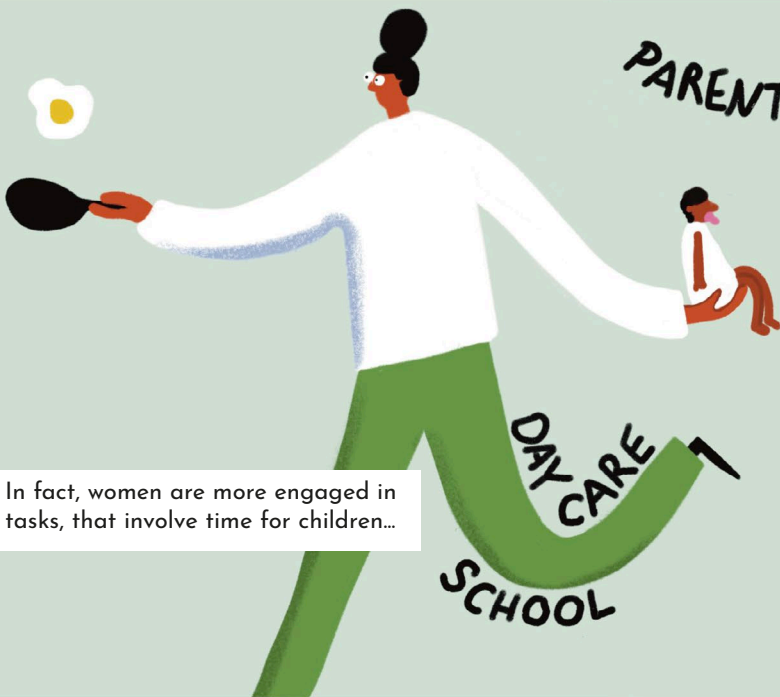
# Who does the paperwork?\*
