to strengthen its research in the field of sustainability in the social sciences at Universität Hamburg commencing **as soon as possible, ref. no. 2259/W3.**

Sustainability relates to social, ecological, and economic aspects, more specifically investigation into what is required in order to secure long-term social welfare and economic wealth, ecological sustainability, liberal social systems, creativity, and societal self-enlightenment.

Responsibilities:

The successful candidate is expected to teach and conduct research in the conduct of life, treating its various forms as practices of socialization, social integration, and sustainable welfare production and sustainable economic activities. A link to intercultural research on globalization, migration, and trans-nationalization is further expected.

The successful candidate is expected to teach in German and English, in particular in the interdisciplinary BA and MA programs in the Department of Socioeconomics and at the Faculty's graduate school, and to dedicate part of this obligation to qualitative social research methods.

Section 12 subsection 7 sentence 2 of the Hamburg Higher Education Act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) applies.

Requirements:

Academic qualifications and additional requirements as specified in Section 15 HmbHG.

Further criteria:

Applicants are expected to have international research experience as well as a successful track record in acquiring external funding and carrying out externally funded projects. The University places particular emphasis on the quality of teaching and therefore requests that applicants provide details of their teaching experience and objectives.

In order to evaluate leadership skills in the areas of management and human resources, an assessment procedure will be conducted with select candidates following a hearing.

In accordance with Section 14 subsection 3 sentence 3 HmbHG, Universität Hamburg seeks to increase the proportion of women in teaching and research and encourages female academics to apply.

Qualified disabled candidates or applicants with equivalent status receive preference in the application process.
