Universität Hamburg invites applications for two Research Associates in accordance with Section 28 subsection 1 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG). The positions commence on 1st April 2018.

Each position is remunerated at the salary level TV-L 13 and calls for 75% of standard work hours per week.*

The fixed-term nature of this contract is based upon Section 2 of the academic fixed-term labor contract act (Gesetz über befristete Arbeitsverträge in der Wissenschaft, WissZeitVG). The initial fixed term is three years.

The University aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching and explicitly encourages women to apply. Equally qualified female applicants will receive preference in accordance with the Hamburg act on gender equality (Hamburgisches Gleichstellungsgesetz, HmbGleiG).

Responsibilities:

Associates will be expected primarily to teach and conduct research. The associate will also have the opportunity to pursue further academic qualifications, in particular a doctoral dissertation. At least one-third of set working hours will be made available for the associate's own academic work.

Specific Duties:

Teaching and research in the area of management accounting and sustainability. The teaching load is 3 teaching hours per week.

Requirements:

A university degree in a relevant field. The candidate is required to have a strong background in the areas of management accounting and/or sustainability and knowledge in empirical methods. Experience with statistical software (e.g., Stata, SAS, R, SPSS etc.) is preferable. An interest in quantitative empirical research, motivation, and the ability to work independently as well as team-oriented are desired.

Severely disabled applicants will receive preference over equally qualified non-disabled applicants.
