Patient choice and socioeconomic disparities in the quality of healthcare: Evidence from Swedish registry data

Abstract:

Socioeconomic inequalities in the access to high-quality care may be mitigated or reinforced when patients are allowed to choose their care provider. We study heterogeneity by socioeconomic status (SES) in patients' choices of primary care provider using administrative data from a Swedish region. We show that SES differences choice behaviour is a driver of disparities in the access to high-quality primary care.
