to support the work of the Sustainability Economics Group led by Prof. Dr. Moritz Drupp.

The research assistant will support research in the project Mapping the Effects of Environmental Policies (MEEP) funded by the Joachim Herz Foundation. MEEP proposes to assemble an open-science, public-service platform featuring interactive, Germany-wide maps of the effects of environmental policies. To this end, MEEP will conduct novel research to fill key knowledge gaps on environmental and socio-economic outcomes of environmental policies and integrate existing research.

Your tasks:

- You will support us primarily with cleaning, preparing and pre-analysing datasets as well as to conduct literature reviews.

The ideal candidate should have:

- experience with empirical analyses and associated programming languages (e.g. R, Stata) and with version control systems (such as Github), or the interest to quickly acquire these
- very good academic performance
- very good knowledge of English
- strong work ethics, good organizational skills, and the ability to work independently
- interest in empirical research as well as in environmental economics and policy

Working time will be 20-40 hours per month with a current gross hourly wage of €15.21 for WHK (€13.25 for SHK), depending on the student's capacity. The contract will be for 12 months. We offer an exciting, dynamic working environment, flexibility in allocating working hours and insights into the research activities of our working group and beyond.
