## Student Research Assistant ("studentische" or "wissenschaftliche Hilfskraft")

for 5-7 hours per week for at least six months (with the option to prolong the contract). The work can be done remotely, hence, physical presence in Hamburg is not required.

We do research and teaching in macroeconomics, with a focus on the role of financial markets in the (international) transmission of shocks and the optimal design of different central bank policies. In large parts, the research is of theoretical nature, developing and employing so-called *Dynamic Stochastic General Equilibrium (DSGE) Models*. Furthermore, modern econometric methods are employed, such as Local Projections, to confront the model with data.

- Support in updating the lecture "Macroeconomics"
- Support in preparing a new lecture concerned with topics in (international) macro-finance
- Updating the chair's homepage
- Assistance in different research projects, e.g., searching scientific literature, supporting the documentation of research outcome

## **Requirements:**

- Student of Socioeconomics or Economics (Bachelor/Master)
- Good knowledge of the subject of macroeconomics, ideally also of international macroeconomics and/or monetary economics
- Good language skills in English and German
- Latex, Stata, Matlab skills are beneficial
