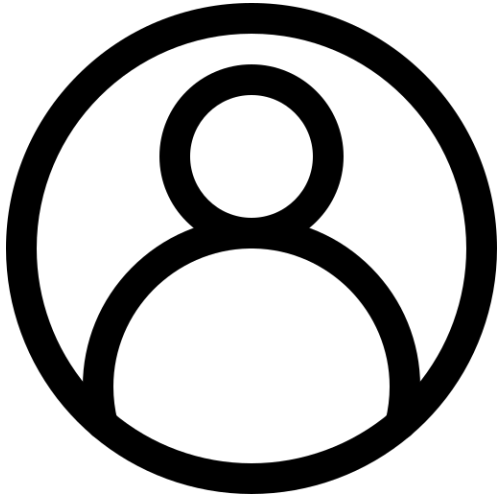

1.1 Three Libraries in Hamburg



- Fachbibliothek Wirtschaftswissenschaften holds subject specific literature on topics of your courses and acquires more literature upon your request.
- Bibliothekssystem UHH is the **10th biggest state and university library** in Germany
- ZBW hosts the **biggest collection** of literature in economics and business administration in Germany

1. Fill out the **application form** on the library homepage: <https://libcard.rrz.uni-hamburg.de/sub/edit.php?lang=en>
2. Go to the library **circulation desk (mon-fri 9-17)**.
Bring your student ID + your passport + your proof of registration.
Sign the application form.
3. = for free, valid for **one year**
= password-protected

4.3 Search terms / 6: Syntax

- Search terms
 - Term = words from the text, i.e. abstract, title, author field
 - Keyword/ Descriptor = are not part of the original text, describe the content
 - Thesaurus = Descriptors in hierarchical order
z.B. Thesaurus Wirtschaft: B Betriebswirtschaft > B.04 Personalmanagement > B.04.04 Arbeitsbedingungen & betriebliche Arbeitsbeziehungen > B.04.04.01 Arbeitsbedingungen > Mitarbeiterbindung
- **Truncation: Word stem search, Wildcard (#/*/?)**
- **Boolean operators:** **UND / AND**  **ODER / OR** 
- Adjacency operators: number of words between search terms
i.e. oil W3 (disaster OR clean-up OR contamination)
- **Phrase search: „xxx xxx“**

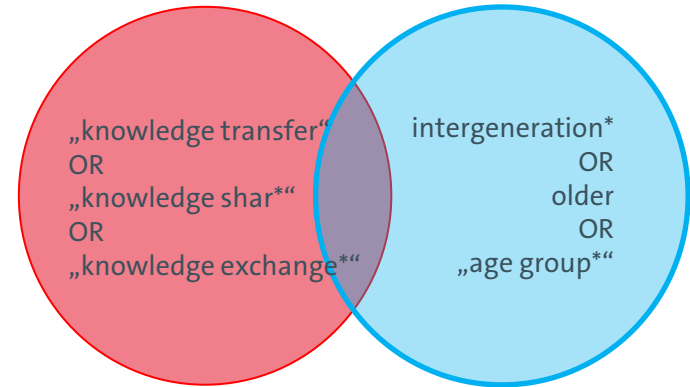

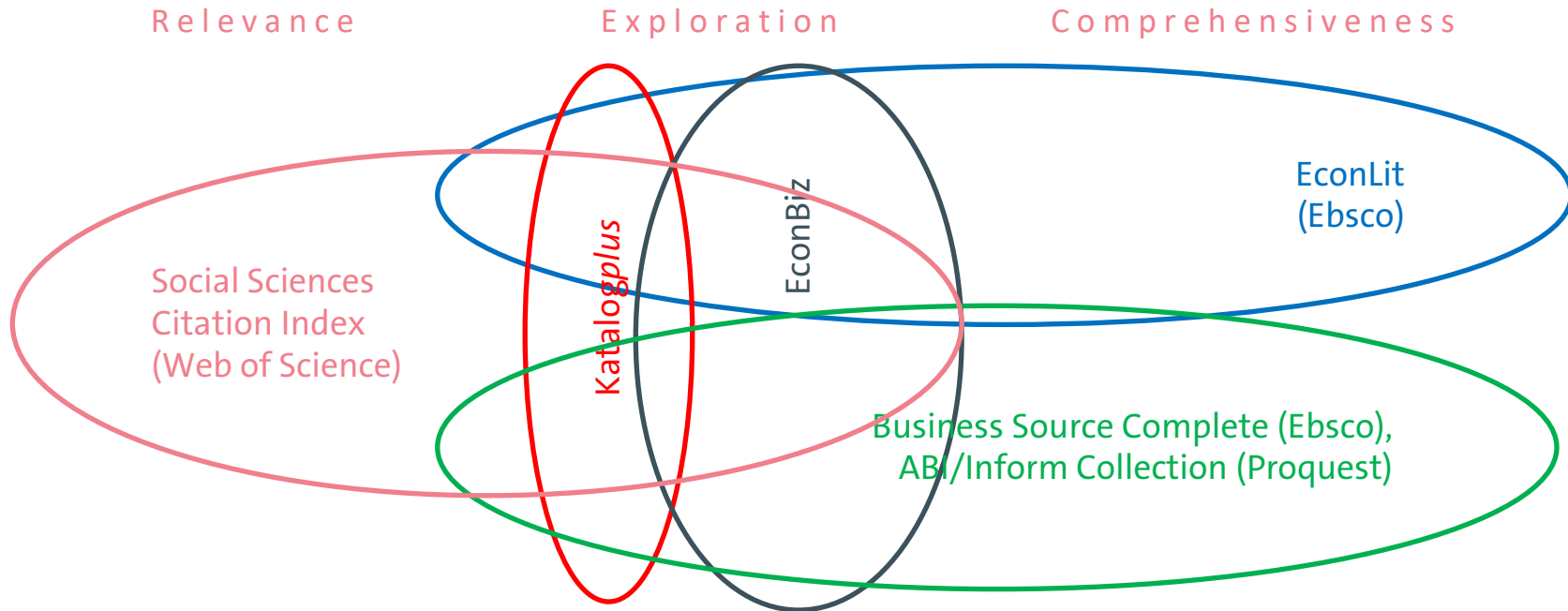

4.6 SSCI 1: My Search string

1. Go to „Advanced Search“.
2. In the field menu, change „All Fields“ to „Topic“.
3. Enter your first concept (English terms only). Click on „Add to Query“ and on **Search**.
4. In the top left corner, go back to „Advanced Search“ and hit „Clear“ to empty the Query Preview.
5. Enter the search string for your **second concept**. Click on „Add to Query“ and on **Search**.
6. In the top left corner, go back to „Advanced Search“ and hit „Clear“ to empty the Query Preview.
7. Combine your searches. Go back to Advanced Search. Scroll down to „Session Queries“. Select relevant searches and click on **AND**.
8. Click on the **number of results** to see the detailed results list.
Note: SSCI only includes articles that are peer reviewed.

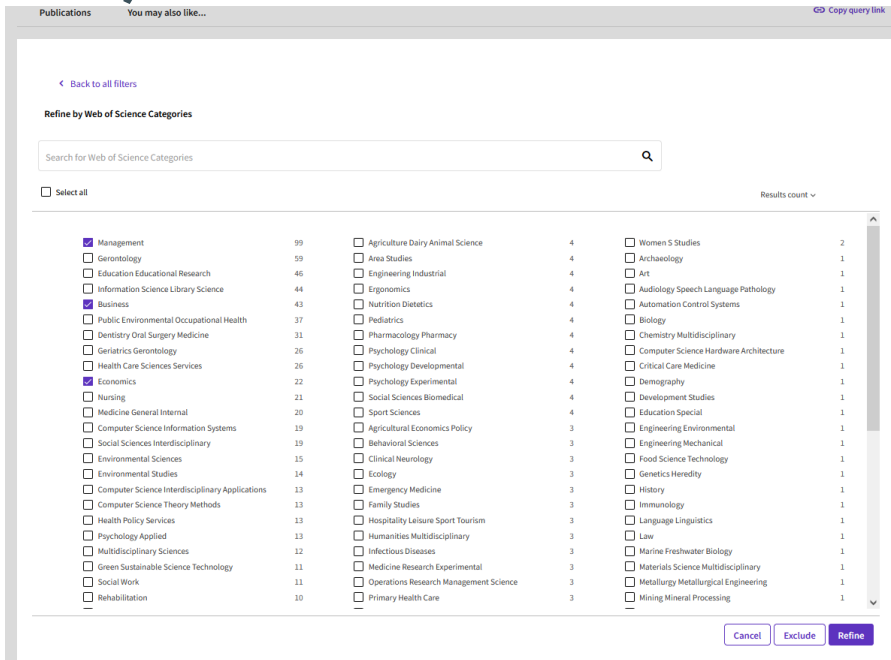

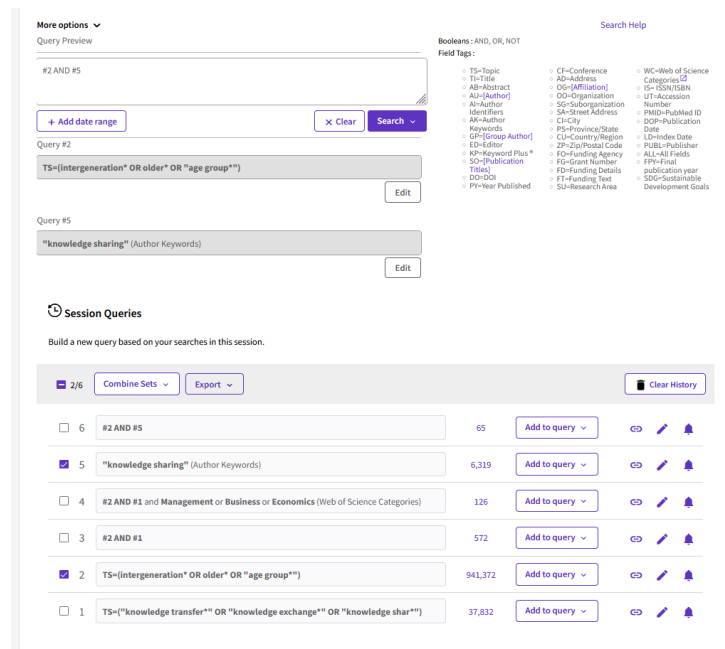
4.6 SSCI 2: First tuning (My ideas)

1. On the left handside, open the filter „**Web of Science Categories**“. Click on „**See all**“ and get a list of all subjects that provide results in your list.
2. Select the relevant subjects.
Click on „**Refine**“.
3. Adapt your search by
 - editing your search string („**Edit**“) and adding or deleting synonyms, or by
 - adding a new search for another concept.



4.6 SSCI 3: Second tuning (Descriptors)

- Take a look at **interesting articles** in the full display. In the **"Keywords"** section you can see the keywords listed in the SSCI:
 - Author Keywords were assigned by the authors and are not standardized.
 - Keywords Plus are automatically generated words based on an analysis of the literature cited by the article.
- Click on interesting keywords and make a note of them for further searches.
- To do this, go back to "Advanced Search" and combine
 - the keywords with each other or
 - replace one concept with the keyword and combine this with your own search string for the other concept.
- Try different combinations.

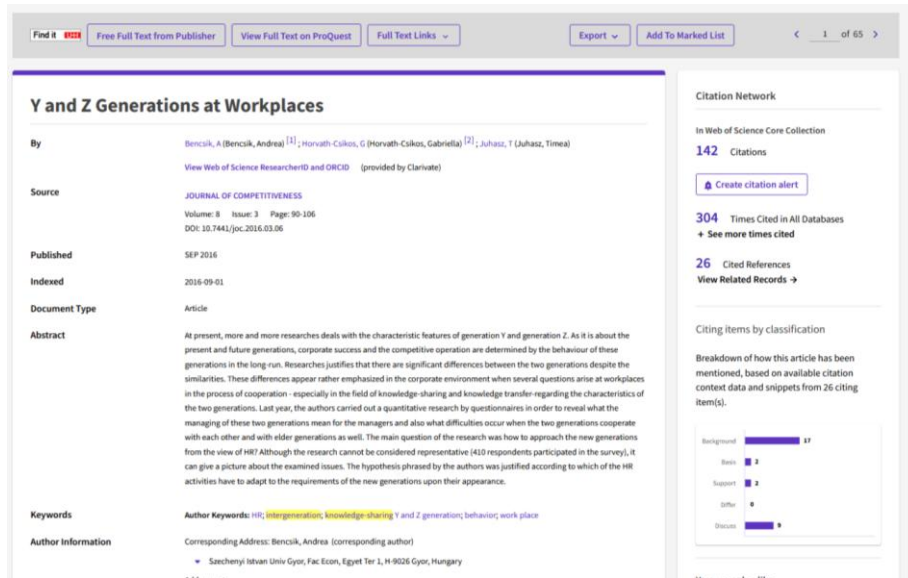

4.6 SSCI 4: Third tuning (Exploration)

1. Display the **list of your hits**. Select “**Citation Report**” at the top on the right side. Here Web of Science analyses the hits according to which have been cited most frequently by other articles. It is assumed that frequently cited literature represents basic literature that can be cited in the introduction to a topic.
2. Take a look at interesting articles in the full display. Use the “**Citation Network**” box in particular:
 - **XX Citations** = how often the article was cited: If you click on the number, the articles are listed.
 - **XX Cited References** = the bibliography of this article: click on the number to list the articles.
 - „**View Related Records**“ = Articles that have a high correspondence to the articles used in the bibliography.

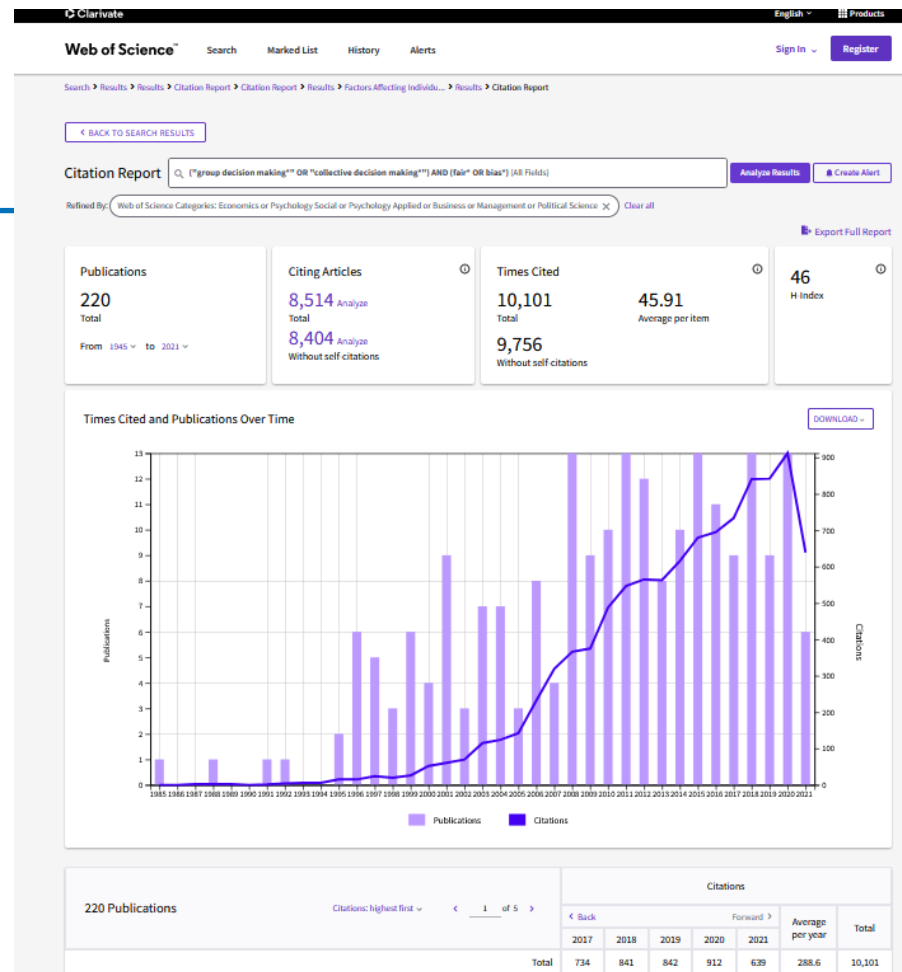

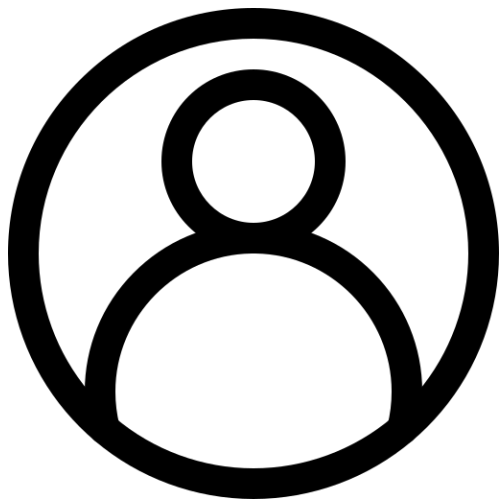

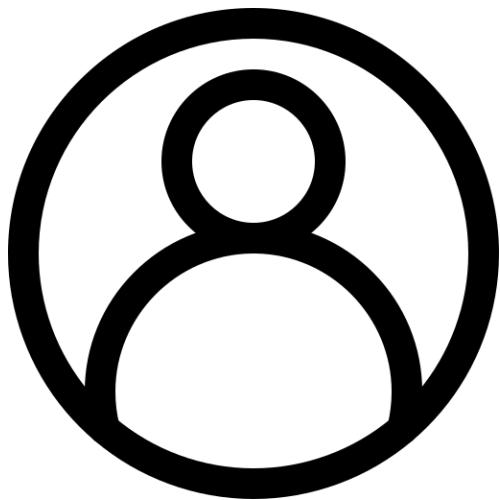
