1.2 KNOW THE CORRECT SYNTAX

- Search terms
 - term / text = words in all text fields, i.e. in the abstract, title or author field
 - keyword / descriptor = describe the content, do not have to be part of the title
 - thesaurus = hierarchy of search terms / topics
 i.e. Standard Thesaurus Wirtschaft: Economics > Microeconomics > Welfare economics
- Truncation: word stem, wildcard (#/*/?)
- Boolean operators: UND / AND (

ODER / OR



- Adjacency operators: distance between two terms
 i.e. oil adj3 (disaster OR clean-up OR contamination)
- Phrase search: "xxx xxx"

2.3 IDENTIFY YOUR CONCEPTS AND TERMS

- 1) Identify the question.
- 2) Identify the major concepts / keywords.
- 3) Consider any alternative keywords or phrases. These could be:
 - related terms
 - spelling variations / including plurals
 - broader terms if you get only a few results
 - narrower terms if you get too many results
- 4) Plan your search
 - write your keywords in a concept box
 - combine keywords using Boolean Operators (AND & OR)
 - truncate terms: truncation symbols vary from database to database
 - limit your search by: English language, year range, review article etc.

- 3) Go to "Search history" and combine your search terms. Restrict your results to "scholarly (peer-reviewed) journals".
- 4) Have a look at your results: do alternative search terms look more promising?
 - i.e. descriptors please note: Only articles, that have been assigned descriptors, will be found if you limit your search to "subject".
- 5) Save the citation and look for the full text. Find it
